Building off the highly successful 2019 Vignettes collection, 2024's **Vignettes** is brighter, softer, ethereal, and more textural. This new assortment comprises indoor textiles and trims with fewer SKUs, resulting in a tighter mix of bolder colors and patterns directly inspired by Kendall's love of fashion and travel, including Israel, Paris, and her beloved California coast.

Kendall believes that "Endless beauty surrounds us each day, and this collection takes note of even the smallest details to invite timeless elegance and allure into your home."

The collection has been curated into three books: **Daybreak** (violets + pinks), **Crystal Spring** (neutrals + soft blues) and **Sapphire Forest** (blues + greens).





The design process began in Spring 2022, kicked off by Kendall's adoration of Blake Lively's magical color-transforming Met Gala dress designed by Donatella Versace. The pink, aqua, and peach tone set the stage for the Daybreak book of textiles and corresponding trim.

Never to be underestimated is the majestic backyard of Kendall's native California, where the climate continues to nurture infinite flora and fauna that informs the sacred geometry of life in color and form. Mother Nature softens the intersection of geometric forms, and the California lifestyle will always weave through Kendall's work. Informed by the many colors of San Francisco and where the sea meets the sand, Crystal Spring encompasses these textures, patterns, and the muted colors of Northern California.

In January 2023, while in Paris for the annual Deco-Off design week, Kendall was deeply moved and inspired by the magnificent Monet & Mitchell exhibition at Fondation Louis Vuitton. The intensity of colors and the many botanical and anamorphic shapes directly inspired new patterns and color work. The many greens and blues in Monet and Mitchell's work are interwoven within the Sapphire Forest book.
