The modern yacht is a triumph of engineering, a pairing of sophisticated yet resilient materials and the pinnacle of grand refinement. An impeccable feat of design that facilitates adventure and indulgence in equal measure.

Grand Sail pairs this notion of oceanic exploration with the safe haven of home. Ease into Grand Sail's deeply sumptuous cushions and delight in the attention to detail as you are supported by finely finished frames and surrounded by premium materials with stylish tables in easy reach. Lie back, relax and dream of the tomorrows to come.

The collection comprises a 2-Seater Sofa, Left and Right End Units and a Centre Unit as well as inline or freestanding Side Tables and a Coffee Table. Frames are formed from striking aluminium horizontals that curve gracefully into mast-like verticals finished in lightly textured, Meteor or Bone colour powder coat. These support sleek outdoor fabric 'sails' fashioned from complementary Blend Coal or Blend Sand fabrics tensioned around a secondary aluminium frame. Seat cushions are topped with large pillows and smaller lumbar cushions. Occasional tables have matching frames and the option of either natural finish teak or ceramic tops in a variety of colours.

Henrik Pedersen, award winning designer from Denmark says of his design; "Every element serves a purpose - to create a soft, cozy setting with modular flexibility. A selection of structured fabrics allows for personalization, and the mix of textiles adds an extra tactile dimension, making the Grand Sail a truly immersive voyage of comforting discovery."
