The Besso collection completes a trilogy of wood furniture inspired by country homes around the world. "Besso," the English translation for the Japanese meaning "holiday house," is the companion to the Quinta and Relais collections.

Inspired by the captivating architecture and design encountered in Hyogo Prefecture, Japan, Besso pays homage to tatami weaving, and the restraint and rhythm of Japanese design and craft. In solid teak or teak frames with handwoven JANUSfiber, the linear backrest is at once substantial and quietly Zen in aesthetic.

The 15-piece collection seamlessly blends beauty and function is available in three neutral finishes: Natural Teak, Driftwood, and Black, inspired by the ancient "Shou Sugi Ban" technique, a traditional Japanese method of charring cedar wood to enhance water resistance and durability.
