ARTISTIC TILE CELEBRATES SUMMER WITH COLORFUL NEW PRODUCTS

SECAUCUS, New Jersey, August 10, 2026—Artistic Tile introduces new products for summer that truly defy expectation with their range of unique colors, expressive textures, and luminous finishes. From amazing quartzite natural stone slabs to textile arts-inspired sculptural tile, this anthology showcases the possibilities of designing with luxe materials.

President and Chief Product Officer Zach Epstein is always expanding our curated collection of natural stone slabs by bringing in high-quality, unique products that highlight the beauty only nature can create. Additions for summer include multiple quartzites from Brazil featuring striking coloration, including Aurora Borealis. "I wanted a quartzite with a lot of color. I saw this and it was just so interesting—who doesn't love the aurora borealis?" Epstein says. "You've got a fantastic turquoise background with gold and red veins, some hints of darker greens here and there... It's a really unbelievable piece of stone."

Additionally, Artistic Tile's Design Department offers two new dimensional tiles based on textile arts—in celebrated natural stone varieties. Arabescato D'Oro Cable is a marble tile with rugged lines reminiscent of hemp mooring ropes, and Reticolo is a limestone tile that displays a complex network. "We wanted to take the intricacy of modern fiber arts and interpret it in stylized stone," explains Design Director Courtney Vagliardo. "And we chose stones that would react in different ways to the dual finishing technique of CNC carving and brushing to produce a variety of textures."

Our summer selection also includes tumbled mosaics inspired by the English countryside. The Cotswold Collection, which includes Clover and Octagon, borrows shapes from rural flora and architecture. An additional new mosaic is Sail Fete Cream, which depicts our popular nautical pattern of triangular shapes in neutral and pastel-colored honed marbles.

New Naica Porcelain comes in large-format tile and broken-joint mosaics, adding to our collection of porcelain mosaics designed for shower use. Natural stone and ceramic tiles, including a 12" x 24" Arabescato Corchia Marble Tile and a much-requested 2" x 6" rectangular Zellige Ceramic Tile, round out the Artistic Tile debuts.

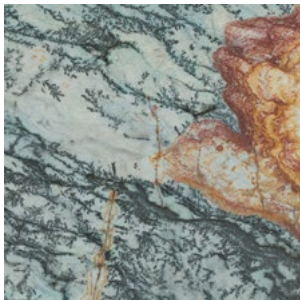

Stone Slabs

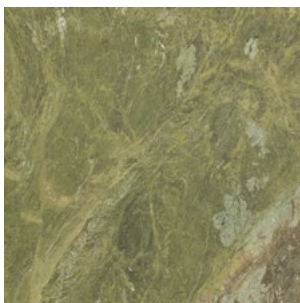
Aurora Borealis Quartzite: Named after the natural light display visible in the Arctic sky, Aurora Borealis Quartzite flaunts a range of celestial colors—its soft green background intersected by mineral veins in pink, purple, emerald, and gold. Atmospheric and majestic, this stone feels almost impossibly radiant with hues as varied and dynamic as a fire opal. Available in ¾" (2 cm) honed stone slabs.



Blue Lava Quartzite: Blue Lava Quartzite combines a pastel blue background with slate patterns, copper swirls, and mahogany accents. This natural stone quarried in Brazil resembles an antique topographic map, its colors reminiscent of canyons, forests, and waterways. Available in ¾" (2 cm) honed stone slabs.



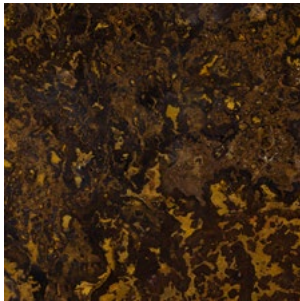
Epidus Green Quartzite: Named after the tropical flora found in Brazilian rainforests, Epidus Quartzite is a deep mossy color with diagonal veins and swirling shapes in sage and forest green. Vivid gold and rust streaks enhance the stone's palette, along with small accents of burgundy, coral, and orange. Available in ¾" (2 cm) honed stone slabs.



Fiji Quartzite: A spectacularly colored stone evocative of tropical flora, Fiji Quartzite displays a lush range of greens, from emerald and jade to melon and chartreuse. Broad bands of brilliant white illuminate the stone, joined by accents of gold, ochre, and rust. Alternating vivid streaks—straight, diagonal, and undulating—give the quartzite a riverlike flow, while impressive white forms drift across the surface like clouds. Available in ¾" (2 cm) polished stone slabs.



Radica Quartzite: A bold copper with bright orange streaks, Radica Quartzite develops its intense color from an iron-rich composition that results in vivid veining. Striking flames dance across this fiery stone, spreading in wavy patterns from edge to edge. Quartz crystals add iridescent spots of opaline white, shimmering black, and a hint of evanescent violet-lavender. Available in ¾" (2 cm) polished stone slabs.



Terra D'Ambar: Terra D'Ambar, meaning amber earth in Portuguese, is an exquisite quartzite from Brazil. Warm colors flow across its surface: cream and peach dissolve into charcoal and rust. Unexpected hues enrich the stone's palette—soft celadon, blush pink, and shimmering gold flakes. Available in ¾" (2 cm) honed stone slabs.



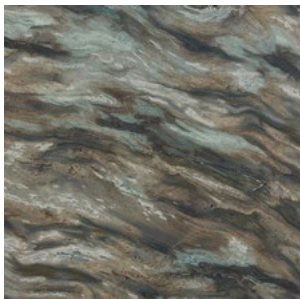
Titanium Travertine: Like its namesake metal, Titanium Travertine displays sections of silver in soft ribbons that float throughout a gray background reminiscent of oyster mushrooms. Taupe and sand flow amid the vein-cut travertine, a cutting technique revealing the layers that created this sedimentary rock. Available in filled and honed vein-cut $\frac{3}{4}$ " (2 cm) stone slabs.



Venatura Quartzite: Named after the Italian word for wood grain, Venatura is a beige and tan stone with hints of red. White quartz veins traverse its warm background, making it look as if the quartz erased the stone's underlying brown hues—giving the quartzite an expressive appearance similar to the hatching technique in pencil drawing. Available in $\frac{3}{4}$ " (2 cm) honed stone slabs.



Verdazite Quartzite: Like an expressionistic painting of windswept woods, Verdazite Quartzite layers green and brown in a kinetic composition. Celadon, sage, and teal make up the stone's background, with dapples of emerald. Taupe, coffee, bark, and espresso overlay the verdant tones. White and gray weave through the quartzite, reminiscent of mist. Available in $\frac{3}{4}$ " (2 cm) honed stone slabs.

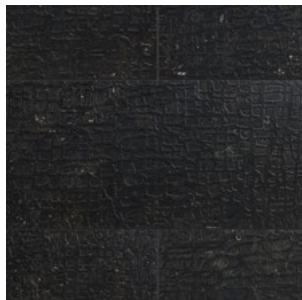


Dimensional Tile

Arabescato D'Oro Marble Cable: Arabescato D'Oro Cable transforms the celebrated gold-veined marble through sculptural linear carving. Defined by a continuous run of rounded, closely spaced ridges with a hand-chiseled character, this dimensional tile feels both ornamental and rugged—paying homage to the marble's decorative power and its elemental texture. Cable coordinates beautifully with Arabescato D'Oro Rock Finish, and pairs equally well with any Arabescato D'Oro slab, tile, or mosaic. Available in 12" x 24" x 1/2" tile.



Reticolo: Meaning network in Italian, Reticolo translates the intricacy of fiber arts to the medium of natural stone. Its surface displays an organic interplay of pattern, sculpted through CNC precision and softened by a brushed finish. This two-layer design captures the individual character of each stone, pairing a lacy, velvety-smooth overlay with a richly textured background—granular Belgian Bluestone, earthy Grey Foussana, and rugged Grey Sabbia. Available in 12" x 24" x 3/8" decorative tile, each coordinating with honed tiles in the same limestone varieties.

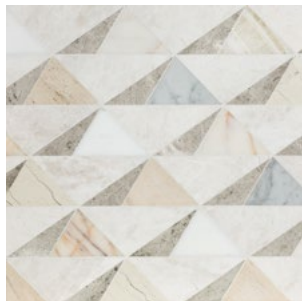


Mosaics

Cotswold Clover and Octagon: The Cotswold Collection is inspired by the charming villages and rolling hills of England's storied countryside. Once home to William Morris, who founded the Arts and Crafts Movement, the rural district features landscapes dotted with fairy tale homes and stone castles. Our two patterns—Cotswold Clover and Cotswold Octagon—pay tribute to the romantic region with their decorative shapes and tumbled finish. Clover's quatrefoil design echoes the ornamental windows of Gothic cathedrals, while Octagon's geometric form recalls the formal courtyards of country estates. The Cotswold Collection is stocked in Belgian Bluestone, Calacatta Gold, and Moca Limestone. Available in 11-1/4" x 12-1/4" x 3/8" tumbled tile.



Sail Fete Cream: Sail Fete weaves triangles of varying sizes into a dynamic geometric composition, evoking the nautical imagery of sails catching the wind. The mosaic's distinctive pattern celebrates the natural beauty of luxurious stone varieties in three handsome colorways. Sail Fete Cream includes Calacatta Gold, Vanilla Onyx, Bianco Antico, Tundra Grey, Calacatta Rosa, Moca, Bianco Carrara, and White Sand—all in a honed finish. Available in 6-5/8" x 31-3/16" x 3/8" waterjet mosaic tile.

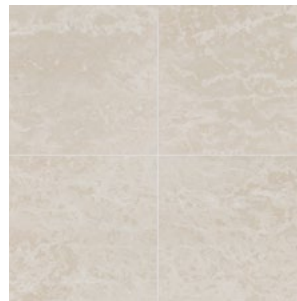


Stone and Ceramic Tile

Arabescato Corchia Marble Tile: Arabescato Corchia is a classic Italian marble with an ivory background and large brecciated veining. Quarried in the Apuan Alps, this Italian stone combines a luminous white color with gray veins and swirls. The tile coordinates with all Arabescato Corchia Slabs. Available in 12" x 24" x 3/8" honed tile and 18" x 18" x 3/8" polished tile.



Botticino Tile: A fine-grained, dense stone prized for its warm beige color and delicate veining, Botticino is a sophisticated neutral marble commonly found in architectural gems, including the iconic staircase at New York's Grand Central Terminal. Our Botticino Marble Tile comes in three distinct finishes, each offering its own hue and texture. Botticino Classico displays the marble's quintessential cream color in a satiny honed finish. Botticino Fiorito, meaning flowery in Italian, features cloudlike patterns. Botticino Classico Sandblasted and Brushed gets its unique look from a two-step finishing process: first the marble is sandblasted to lighten and texturize the tile, then it is brushed to a smooth finish that is soft to the touch. Botticino Classico Honed and Botticino Classico Sandblasted and Brushed are available in 12" x 24" x 3/8" tile, and Botticino Fiorito is available in 18" x 18" x 3/8" honed tile.



Zellige 2" x 6": Handmade by Moroccan tile artisans with generations of experience creating bespoke ceramic tile, the Zellige Collection offers extraordinary versatility for walls, floors, and backsplashes. Following ancient tradition, artisans shape and glaze each tile by hand, imbuing each with its own character. Cloud White and Sand are now available in 2" x 6" x 1/2" subway tile. All Zellige tiles in 4" x 4" format are available in 10 colors.



Porcelain Tile and Mosaic

Naica Porcelain Tile: A versatile neutral with subtle patterns, Naica Porcelain Tile blends beige and gray hues with cream veining. Made to blend well with Naica natural stone slabs, Naica Porcelain Tile offers similar colors in a large-format tile designed for high-traffic areas and commercial spaces. Available in 24" x 48" x 3/8" matte tile.



Naica Porcelain Mosaic: Purpose-built for shower floors, our 3 cm porcelain broken-joint mosaics offer the sought-after appeal of Bardiglio Marble, Naica Quartzite, Smoke, and Grey Foussana Limestones in a nonporous mosaic with the rustic, asymmetrical look that makes broken joint so appealing. These porcelain alternatives were specifically designed to offer the aesthetic of natural stone without the risk of drain-area shadowing caused by water absorption. Pair our porcelain broken-joint mosaics with the coordinating natural stone for a seamless look.
