“Jamie Young Co.’s DNA remains the same: understated elegance that is easy to live with,” added Young. “This season, we went deeper into furniture than we ever have. We wanted pieces with real presence—solid oak case goods, incredibly comfortable seating, plush upholstery, lighting with scale and femininity, and table lamps made from authentic materials. When you bring together the details, textures, color palette, and scale, it creates a collection that feels both elevated and incredibly livable.”

The Fall 2026 Collection reflects a thoughtful balance of big scale, warm tones, rich texture, and enduring craftsmanship across every category of the home. Glamorous without feeling precious and sophisticated without sacrificing comfort, the collection captures Jamie Young Co.'s ability to create interiors that feel both considered and personal—pieces that make a room feel finished, while still leaving room for the people who live in it.
